Ceramic or Porcelain

- Created from a mixture of clays

- Available in an array of colors and textures



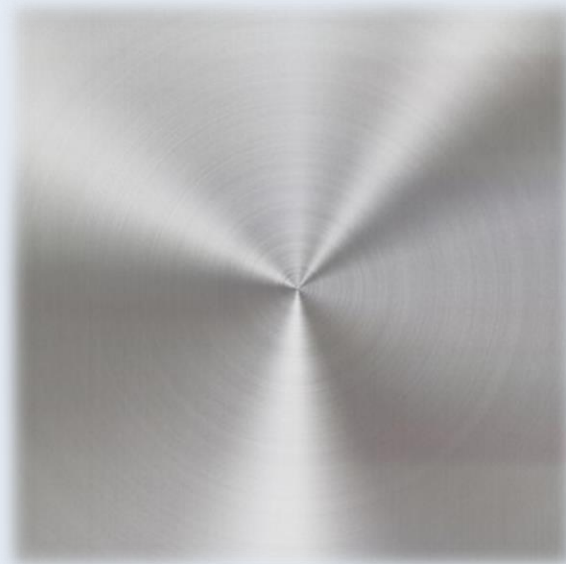
Limestone
